

STARTER QUESTION:

Who are the people in my community who are different from me who I tend to interact with infrequently?

Connect

5-10 min

Pray with your group as you connect with God's truth in this lesson.

Share a short, good news story of what God is doing in your life. Have 1-2 people share what happened when they took small steps of obedience from last week's "I Will Statement."

Watch the Video and Discuss

10-15 min

What did you discover about why we love our neighbor?

Study

30-45 min

Remind one another of the rules of etiquette

- Rule #1 Speak in sentences (not paragraphs).
- Rule #2 Stick to today's scripture.

Choose the scripture passage

- Luke 10:25-37 The Parable of the Good Samaritan
- Luke 6:27-36 Love for Enemies

Have two people read it.

If there is time, have your group retell the story together, in your own words.

Step 1: Discover

5-10 min

Discover more by asking observation questions. Don't interpret just yet.

What stood out to you? What word or phrase caught your attention?

Step 2: Deepen

15-25 min

Learn more by asking interpretation questions, such as:

What did you learn about God?

What did you learn about people?

What did you learn about why we love our neighbors?

Ask additional interpretation questions like: who, what, where, when, how, and why.

Step 3: Do

5 min

Take time to pray silently, listening for how God would have you obey.

What can you do about what you discovered this week? What small steps of obedience can you take?

Write down an "I WILL Statement." Keep it simple and specific.

As the Holy Spirit leads me, this week I WILL...

Share your "I Will Statements"

Pray over what God is leading you to do this week.

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What did you discover about God speaking through culture?
